Manager's Message

Happy July! I hope everybody is enjoying the nicer summer weather we have been experiencing. Please notify the Front Desk if you are experiencing any issues with your air conditioning in your apartment. In some cases, we can educate on how to use your thermostat properly, but in other cases, maintenance will need to complete repairs to your AC unit.

We received several questions regarding the COVID-19 boosters at June's Focus Meeting. I have updated the Focus notes included in this newsletter as well. To be considered up-to-date on your COVID shots, you should have received the initial vaccine series (2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna OR 1 dose of J&J). If you have received the 1st series, you may receive the 1st booster after 4 months of your 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna, or 2 months after J&J. If you are over 50 years of age and 4 months out from your first booster, it is recommended that you receive a 2nd booster. Your 2nd booster MUST be Pfizer or Moderna. Please contact me directly if you are in need of any dose of the series. The Villa is able to provide COVID-19 vaccines and boosters on Wednesdays; however we need completed consent forms for the residents receiving the shots the week

prior. Specific eligibility requirements can be found at https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/stay-up-to-date

We began replacing bathroom vanities in market-rate 1-bedroom units at the end of June. You should receive a notice on the date that your vanity will be replaced. If you did not receive a notice earlier in June regarding your vanity replacement, it is because of one of a few reasons: 1.) Your apartment layout is not an A-style layout 2.) You are in a HUD unit 3.) Your vanity has previously been replaced. This is part of a refinance project at the Villa to upgrade our original structures to newer models.
